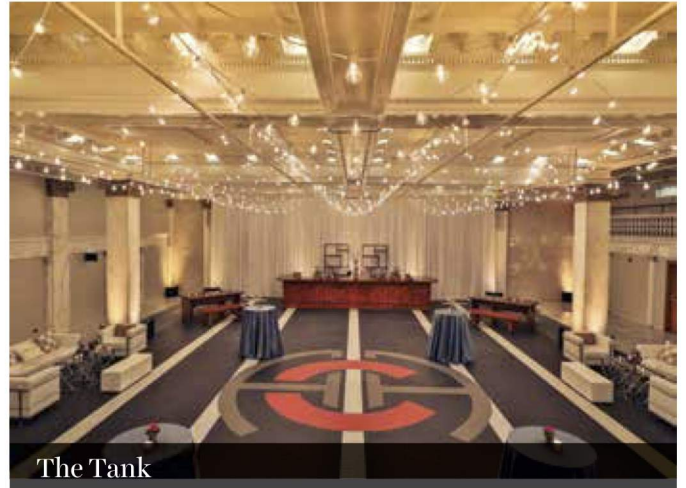

Located on Chicago's Cultural Mile, across from Millennium Park and in the heart of the central business district, the Chicago Athletic Association Hotel seamlessly blends its storied legacy as one of the nation's most revered social clubs with modern day sophistication. Inside this 1890's monument to the big shouldered, can-do spirit that defines our city, you will find 240 guest rooms and suites with contemporary amenities throughout.

The Chicago Athletic Association Hotel offers 17,000 square feet of iconic spaces that effortlessly meld past with present. Open to the public for the first time since 1893, meeting, event and wedding rooms feature original stained glass windows, mantels with extraordinary bas-relief woodcarvings, marble staircases and millwork of stunning character and detail. At every corner, restorers and designers took extraordinary care to marry 19th century glamour with contemporary sophistication in an elegant playground for some of Chicago's finest rooms and event experiences.

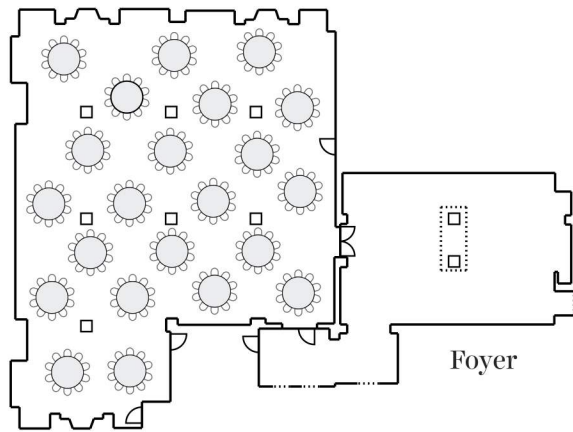

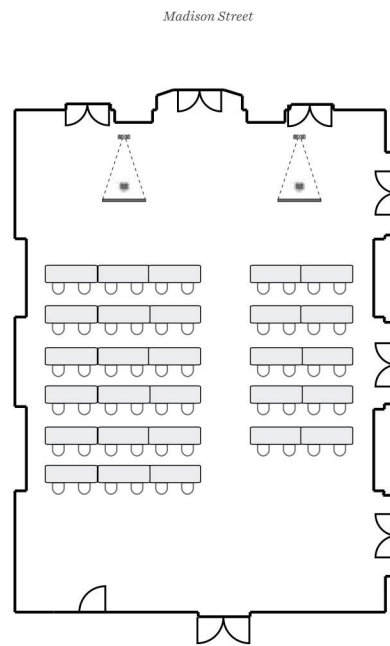

Evers Board Room

Tinker, Evers and Chance Board Rooms

Tinker, Evers and Chance offer traditional executive spaces for parties looking to invite a spirit of play into the boardroom. These meeting rooms can accommodate group sizes from 8 to 30, with the option of being reserved individually, or as a roster of three: the Tinker room accommodates conference seating of 12, the Evers room offers conference seating of 30, and the Chance room affords an intimate meeting of 10 seated. The spaces are affectionately named to honor the three men to whom the Chicago Cubs owe their World Series title win in 1908.

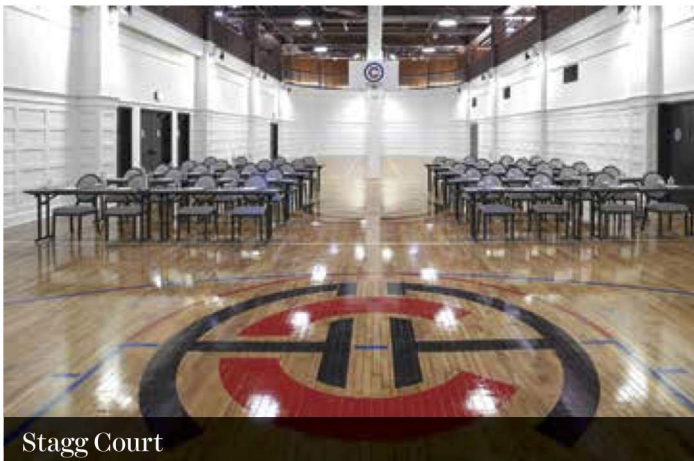

Madison Ballroom

The Madison Ballroom invites guests to experience the sophistication of Chicago's central business district with floor-to-ceiling windows that look onto the bustling Chicago 'Loop' cityscape beneath the glow of an original 19th century chandelier. Builders artfully returned the Madison Ballroom to its original color scheme and carefully restored room millwork, stained glass and original walnut parquet flooring. The impeccably updated interiors offer views of Madison Street below for seated events up to 170.



Stagg Court

White City Ballroom

Lit by floor-to-ceiling windows that open directly onto Millennium Park, the White City Ballroom is a breathtaking expression of Chicago grandeur. Lined by three colossal 19th century fireplaces carved with oak bas-relief, original stained glass and a ceiling of 167 'stalactite' embellishments and light fixtures, the White City Ballroom offers a reception capacity of 400 and a seated capacity of 250 atop a painstakingly restored Carrera marble floor.

Stagg Court

Named for the original club member and University of Chicago Coach AA Stagg, Stagg Court transforms the original gymnasium and basketball court into a multipurpose stadium, marrying the whimsical nostalgia of the court's past to its present-day events function. Stagg Court's original gym flooring is restored beneath the vintage running track that encircles the room from one story above. In homage to the past, two vintage basketball hoops hang above, similar to those that once adorned the court. Stagg Court can accommodate 280 for seated events and up to 500 reception style.



Cindy's Rooftop

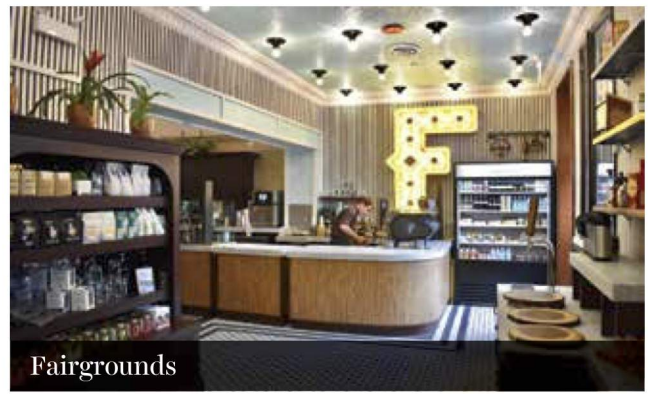
Cindy's

Located on the thirteenth floor atop the hotel, Cindy's boasts an airy atmosphere reminiscent of a Great Lakes beach house, sitting perched above Millennium Park within an atrium of steel and glass mimicking the former train sheds that once lined tracks opposite the hotel. Executive Chef Christian Ragano and his team offer classic family-style comfort food, bio-dynamic wines and award-winning cocktails. The private dining room at Cindy's is affectionately named 'The Library' in honor of our namesake Cindy Pritzker, founder of the Chicago Public Library Foundation. Cindy's provides a flexible dining area that can accommodate breakfast for 125 seated, and group and evening buyouts for 150 people.

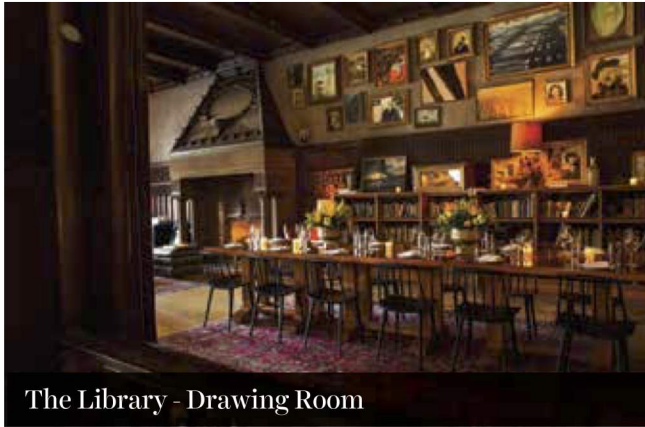
