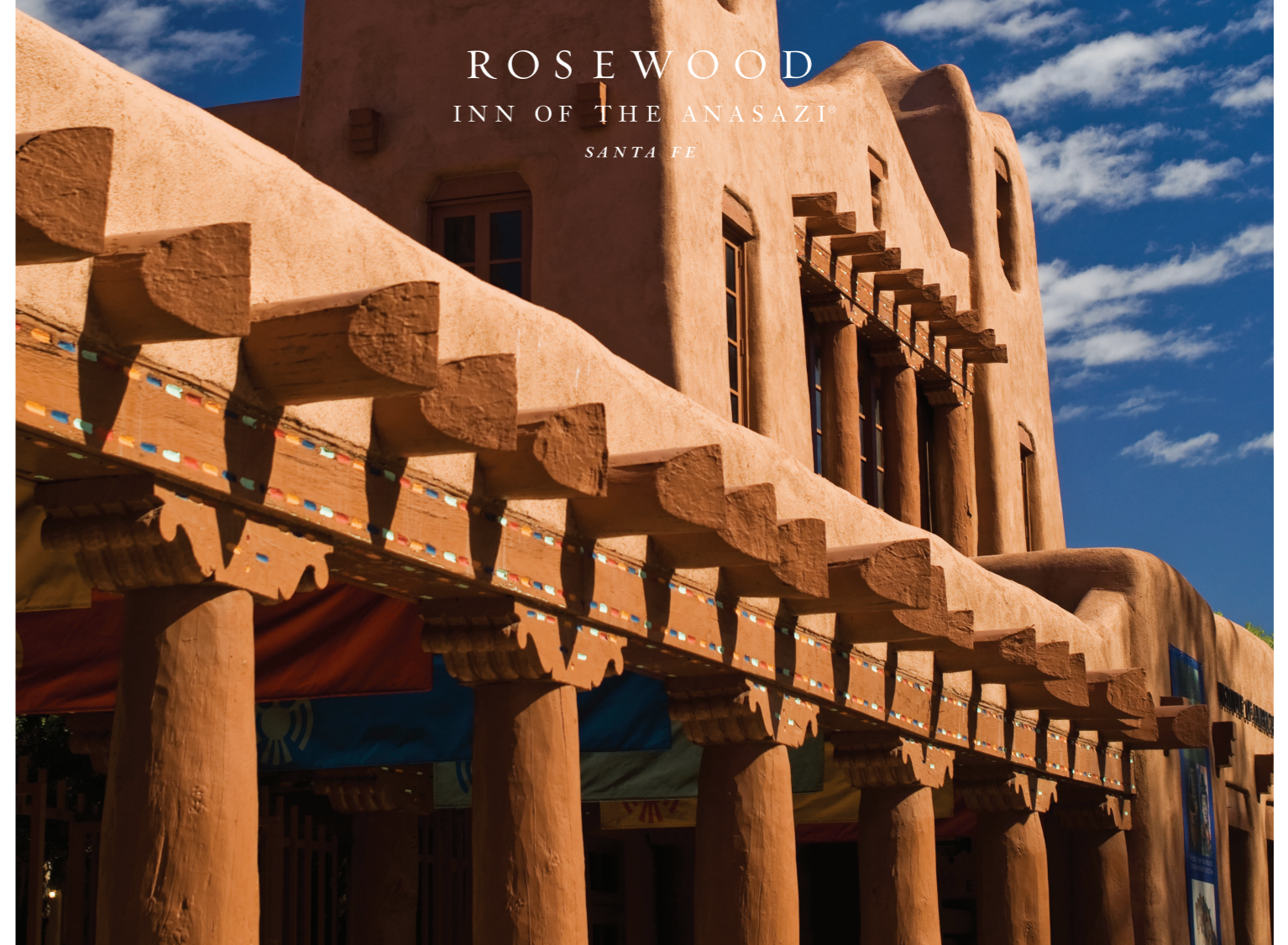

LOCATION

Set in the cultural heart of New Mexico's capital, the Inn is situated just steps from the city's galleries, shops, museums and the historic Santa Fe Plaza. The surrounding area offers activities for the adventurous spirit with seasonal pursuits such as hiking, mountain biking, skiing, white-water rafting and golf; popular destinations such as Canyon Road, Taos and Bandelier National Park are all within driving distance.

ACCOMMODATION

The Inn features 57 rooms and one suite, all with handcrafted furnishings, traditional wooden ceilings and kiva fireplaces. Guest room interiors reflect a modern, sophisticated aesthetic while still celebrating the hotel's Southwestern spirit. A restful palette of natural earth tones, thoughtful accents and upscale amenities combine to create a fresh residential sensibility – an elegant retreat with timeless appeal.

DINING

· **ANASAZI RESTAURANT:** Inspired by Santa Fe's rich cultural and culinary history, the menus fuse old world techniques with modern, innovative recipes and artful plating. The dishes fully embrace the Inn's Southwestern and native heritage and are consistently changing and adapting to reflect the freshest, most seasonal local ingredients.

· **THE BAR:** Popular with both visitors and locals, the bar is best known for its classic cocktails, locally brewed beers and Southwestern-inspired menu.

· **THE PATIO:** The New Mexican sunset beckons travelers to relax and dine al fresco. A charming place to take in the rhythm of the nearby Santa Fe Plaza, the patio features a small plate menu, made-to-order margaritas and more.
